All Members, in particular a Child or Adult at Risk, should feel comfortable, and be encouraged to, speak up and report any concerns they may have or be aware of in relation to the safeguarding of Children and Adults at Risk in football.

The club acknowledges that staff, members and volunteers provide a valuable contribution to the experiences of Children and Adults at Risk involved in football. The club aim to continue this and to take measures to protect the safety and wellbeing of all Children and Adults at Risk participating in football.
